

## **April 2024 Council Highlights**

The **Joint Municipal Safety and Well-Being Plan**, presented by Patrick Finnegan, was adopted by Council. Community safety and well-being planning was been mandated by the Ontario government. The <u>plan</u> is available for your interest.

Council approved the **2023 Financial Statements** as prepared and presented by Welch LLP. The statements can be found on the <u>Township website</u>.

Four members of the **public spoke to Council**. Topics included requests for the waiving of Facility Rental Fees and the Short-Term Accommodations By-law. The presentations are available in the recording of the meeting found on the <u>Township's YouTube Channel</u>.

Discussion took place regarding the proposed **Clean Yards By-law.** Council decided to defer the by-law until the May meeting.

The proposed road names for the **Granite Village** subdivision received preliminary approval, and a Zoning By-law Amendment pertaining to the subdivision was approved. Details are included in the reports as part of the <u>Agenda</u>.

Decision was made to allow for the temporary installation of private (previously existing) **docks on Madawaska Street**, pending the signing of the License of Occupation by the dock owner.

Council directed the CAO to review options for developing a **Village and Waterfront Plan**. The preliminary options will be presented and reviewed as part of the 2025 budget.

The **Short-Term Accommodation Licensing** By-law was approved. The Township's STA webpage will be updated with information to assist all STA owners with the registration process.

**Other Items from April 2024,** Building Permit Report, Granular Crushing Tender awarded, Calabogie Motorsports Park Special Events Permits aproved, Procurement Policy, Asset Retirement Obligation Plan.
