## **TENDER REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. The Contractor hereby offers to furnish all machinery, tools, apparatus, and materials.
- 2. Insurance

General Liability Insurance shall be issued on an occurrence basis for an amount of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence. Such insurance shall include but is not limited to bodily injury and property damage including loss of use; personal injury; contractual liability; premises, property & operations; non-owned automobile; broad form property damage.

Such insurance shall add the Township of Greater Madawaska as Additional Insured with respect to the operations of contractor. This insurance shall be noncontributing with and apply as primary and not as excess of any insurance available to the Township.

The Policies shown above shall not be cancelled unless the Insurer notifies the Township in writing at least sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of the cancellation. The insurance policy will be in a form and with a company which are, in all respects, acceptable to the Township.

The Contractor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Township from all costs, losses, damages, judgments, claims, demands, suits, actions, or other proceedings in any manner based upon, occasioned by, or attributable to anything done or omitted to be done by the Contractor, its directors, officers, employees, agents or volunteers in connection with services provided.

**3.** The successful bidder shall also deliver proof of Worker's Safety & Insurance Board (WSIB) coverage.

### PROCEDURES

- Notification of Acceptance of tender will be by telephone and in written form of the notice, to the address of the Contractor used on the bid forms. The date of Acceptance shall be deemed to be the date of receipt of the Acceptance Notice by the contractor.
- 3. A tender may be voided by superseding it with a later tender or letter of withdrawal, prior to the closing date and time.

# **BASIS OF REJECTION OF TENDER**

Tenders not conforming to the following requirements will be disqualified:

- 1. Tender must be legible, in ink or by printer.
- 2. Tender must be in possession of the Township by the closing date and time.
- 3. Tender must be on form provided.
- 4. Tender must be signed and sealed by an authorized official of the bidding organization. A joint tender must be signed and sealed by each company.
- 5. Tender must not be restricted or modified in any way.

### SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR GRINDING

- 1. The grind pile can be viewed by appointment by contacting Leonard Emon at 613752-2249.
- 2. Price must include grinding of all items including but not limited to box springs, mattresses, and chesterfields including the light metals these items consist of.
- 3. Material must be ground down to a diameter no greater than 0.15 meters (6").
- 4. Contractor must not operate equipment or do any grinding when the site is open to the public every Saturday, Sunday and Wednesday.
