Submission Instructions

1. Bidding System Registration

To obtain documents online please visit <https://greatermadawaska.bidsandtenders.ca> You can preview the bid documents with a Preview Watermark prior to registering for the opportunity. Documents are not provided in any other manner.

2. Submission of Tenders

Tenders must be submitted electronically through the bidding system at:

Submissions by other methods will not be accepted.

In the event of any technical issues, respondents should contact the bidding system's technical support.

3. Tenders to be Submitted on Time

Tenders must be finalized and fully uploaded in the bidding system on or before the Submission Deadline of March 27, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. The time of receipt of Tenders will be determined by the bidding system web clock. Late submissions will not be accepted by the bidding system and will be disqualified as late.

Respondents are cautioned that the timing of submission is based on when the tender is received by the bidding system, not when a tender is submitted by a respondent. As transmission can be delayed due to file transfer size, transmission speed, or other technical factors, respondents should plan to submit tenders well in advance of the submission deadline.

The bidding system will send a confirmation email to the respondent advising when the tender is submitted successfully. If you do not receive a confirmation email, contact the bidding system's technical support immediately.

4. Withdrawal of Tenders

Prior to the Submission Deadline, respondents may withdraw a submitted tender through the bidding system. To withdraw a tender after the Submission Deadline, a notice of withdrawal must be sent to RFT Contact and must be signed by an authorized representative of the respondent.

5. Tender Acceptance

The selected respondent will be notified by email and/or telephone. The owner reserves the right to reject any or all Tenders or to accept any Tender should it be deemed to be in their best interest to do so.

Tenders which are incomplete, conditional, or obscure, or which contain additions not called for, erasures, alterations, or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected as informal.

Ability And Experience of Bidder

The owner reserves the right to reject the Tender of any bidder who does not furnish satisfactory evidence of sufficient capital, plant, and experience to successfully prosecute and complete the work in the specified time.

Responsibilities of the Bidder

Liability Insurance

Commercial General Liability Insurance shall be issued on an occurrence basis for an amount of not less than \$5,000,000. per occurrence / \$5,000,000. annual aggregate for any negligent acts or omissions by contractor relating to their obligations under this Agreement. Such insurance shall include but is not limited to bodily injury and property damage including loss of use; personal injury; contractual liability; premises, property & operations; non-owned automobile; broad form property damage.

Such insurance shall add the Township of Greater Madawaska as Additional Insured with respect to the operations of contractor. This insurance shall be non-contributing with and apply as primary and not as excess of any insurance available to the Township.

Automobile liability insurance with respect to owned or leased vehicles used directly or indirectly in the performance of the services covering liability for bodily injury, death and damage to property with a limit of not less than \$5,000,000 inclusive for each and every loss.

The Policies shown above shall not be cancelled unless the Insurer notifies the Township in writing at least sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of the cancellation. The insurance policy will be in a form and with a company which are, in all respects, acceptable to the Township.

The Township reserves the right to request additional insurance (ie. Environmental Liability Coverage) to comply with exposure associated with a particular job.

The Contractor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Owner from all costs, losses, damages, judgements, claims, demands, suits, actions, or other proceedings in any manner based upon, occasioned by or attributable to anything done or omitted to be done by the Contractor, its directors, officers, employees, agents, or volunteers in connection with services provided.

Contractor shall forward a certified copy of the policy or certificate thereof to the municipality before the work is started.

Workplace Safety and Insurance Board

The Contractor must provide a current Workplace Safety and Insurance Board Clearance Certificate to be eligible for specified works.

Regulations

The Contractor shall abide, if applicable, by the requirements of the Industrial Standards Act, the Employment Standards Act and any other Acts or By-Laws, which are relative to the performance of the work.

Conditions of Tender

The Contractor has carefully examined the provisions, plans, specifications and conditions attached to this Tender and has carefully examined the site and location of the work to be done under this contract, and the Contractor understands and accepts the said provisions, plans, specifications and conditions, and for the prices set forth in this Tender, hereby offers to furnish all machinery, tools, apparatus and other means of construction, furnish all materials, except as otherwise specified in the contract, and to complete the work in strict accordance with the provisions, plans, specifications and conditions attached to this Tender.

Tenders shall be open for acceptance for a period of 30 days after the closing date. After this time, the Tender may only be accepted with the consent of the successful bidder.

It is agreed that the Tender quantities are estimated only and may be increased or decreased by the municipality without alteration of the contract price. However, should such an increase or decrease exceed 20%, then either party to the contract may request, in writing, that negotiations be carried out to determine if a revised unit price would be appropriate.

The Contractor must notify the Township a minimum of 48 hours prior to commencing the work.

Description of work

To crush limestone rock material that has been stockpiled at 12470B Lanark Road for the purpose of crushing into "M" material. The Township of Greater Madawaska owns the limestone rock material and is stockpiled on Township Property. There is no cost to the contractor for the material, the tender is for Crushing and stockpiling only. SPECIFICATIONS FOR GRANULAR MATERIAL

Description

This specification covers the municipality’s requirements for supplying, crushing as required, hauling, placing, spreading and shaping and stockpiling at specified municipal sites.

Materials

Granular materials shall be of such quality that the petrographic number, as determined by petrographic analysis shall not be greater than 250 for 7/8” and 5/8” crushed granular materials, Type B, C & M

MEASUREMENT FOR PAYMENT

Measurement for payment of granular materials will include only those materials incorporated into the work and accepted by the Road Superintendent.

(a) Tonnage Measurements

The Contractor shall provide proof of amount of material in stockpile.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

Granular Materials

Payment at the contract price shall be compensation in full for performing the work specified in the Tender item and for the supply of all labour, equipment, and material except as otherwise provided necessary to complete the work to the satisfaction of the Road Superintendent.

Other Information

If successful, a Granular ‘M’ sieve analysis test meeting the OPSS 1010 specifications for Granular ‘M’ aggregates will be taken by Municipal employees from the pile being used and tested at the expense of the Contractor.
